The drama department has organised a trip to see 'Silver Lining' at the Oxford Playhouse on Thursday 23rd February 2017. The trip will give Year 11 students the opportunity to fulfil the GCSE coursework requirements of watching a live performance and writing an evaluation.

Silver Lining is the hilarious and heart breaking new comedy by writer, actor, presenter and political activist Sandi Toksvig.
