Dear Parents/Carers,

The Black Country Museum Trip will take place on Friday 5th June 2015.

Students going on the trip will not need to wear school uniform, but a suitable coat and sun protection will be essential. We do expect students to be dressed appropriately for a school trip and as the site is large and uneven suitable shoes such as trainers are essential. We recommend that students take a packed lunch as food outlets at the Black Country Museum (including the fish and chip shop) are expensive. If your child takes a mobile phone to use as a camera or takes any other valuables, neither the school nor the Black Country Museum will accept responsibility if it is lost or damaged.

The trip will set off at 8.30 am after registration and aims to return by 6pm, depending on traffic. Could we ask parents collecting their children by car on that day not to park in the bus park, but in the lower visitor's car park to ensure a safe return.
