Dear Parents / Carers

Thank you for your help in the payment of this year's trip to Cornbury Park, 8th-10th June. For your further information please see overleaf the suggested kit list from the Bushcraft Company. Additionally, your son/daughter will have been given a Consent/Medical Form to bring home to you for you to complete.

Please read through all information carefully and return Consent/Medical Form no later than Thursday, 5th May 2016 to your child's Form Tutor. The kit list is only a suggestion, please do not go out and buy lots of additional expensive items that may not be required.

The trip will run Wednesday to Friday. Students should come into school as normal with their luggage on the Wednesday and will return to school at around 2.00p.m. on the Friday.

Whilst at Cornbury Park, instruction will be led by the Bushcraft staff, Wood Green staff will be in attendance at all times. The trip is designed to be physical and challenging in the main with problem solving and team building a key part of the activities. The trip will have three separate camps of 50-60 students these will be decided prior to our departure. Once in these camps, they will be divided into tribes for many of the activities.

All food will be provided by the Bushcraft Company, although students may take some additional snacks if they wish to do so. Accommodation is in the form of large, lined tents sleeping groups of up to ten.

Electronic equipment is not encouraged on the trip and, if taken, is the responsibility of the students. Mobile phones are the responsibility of the students, although there was very little signal, if any, on previous visits. All medical information needs to be recorded on the forms mentioned above. If you have any medical problems that you would like to discuss, please contact myself or your child's tutor. First Aid will be provided on the trip when needed.
