

Dear Year 7 & 8 Parents

Would you like your child to grow in confidence with their Maths, gain experience and improve their skills at applying solutions and solving problems, and to support them to achieve the best results they can?

I am offering after-school Maths tutoring workshops with a difference. These will be activity/project based, working in small groups to allow students to put their Maths skills to the test, interpret and understand problems, relate maths to real life scenarios, learn and practice problem solving skills, and dare I say it, generally have fun with Maths! They will be designed to complement the curriculum they are following in school, and will be structured to support all levels and abilities. They will support your child to firmly grasp the basics and encourage them to stretch themselves as much as possible in a fun and safe environment.

These groups will be small to ensure the quality and attention necessary to really support your child and so I am initially asking that all parents interested in this for their son/daughters please email me so that I can assess interest and organise how many sessions I will need to offer.

If you are interested to find out more please email me by Friday 21st October at ecpmathstutoring@gmail.com with your contact details, name of your child, their age, form class, and current Maths level. Please also include details of any days your child would not be able to attend after school as this will then help me to plan how many groups are needed and which days are best to run them to provide for as many children as possible.

Sessions will be 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ hours long, run over term time only, once a week straight after school on the school premises, and will consist of a 12-week course over 2 terms. There is a charge of £120 per child per course, with full payment being required in advance to secure your place. Due to limited spaces it will be on a first come first served basis. There will be 3 courses offered per academic year and a 15% discount offered to all children booked in advance for the full year (only 2 courses for 2016/17 school year).

I will directly contact interested parents following the autumn school holidays with more information about myself and the workshops to consider and to offer a further discussion to help you decide if you would like to enrol your child ready for January.

I am excited for the opportunity to work with and support your children grow in confidence with Maths, and I look forward to hearing from you.
