Year 12 Visit to Trinity College, Oxford

I have organised a visit to Trinity College, Oxford, on Wednesday 21 October. This is an excellent opportunity for Year 12 students to find out more about life at the University of Oxford and to decide whether it is somewhere they would like to apply to next year.

The schedule for the day is as follows:

- 10.45 am Arrival and introduction to Oxford University
- 11.15 am Q&A session with current students
- 12.00 pm Lunch in Dining Hall
- 12.30 pm Tour of Trinity College
- 1.00 pm Tour of a second college (to be confirmed)

There will then be two hours of free time to visit other parts of the university, such as other colleges or one of the university museums.

There is no charge for this trip but students will be expected to make their own way to and from Oxford using public transport. Students should arrive at the college on Broad Street by 10.30 am and I will meet them there.
