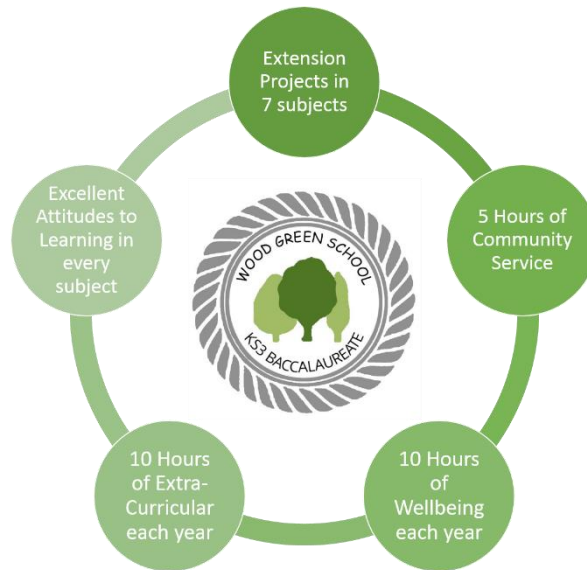

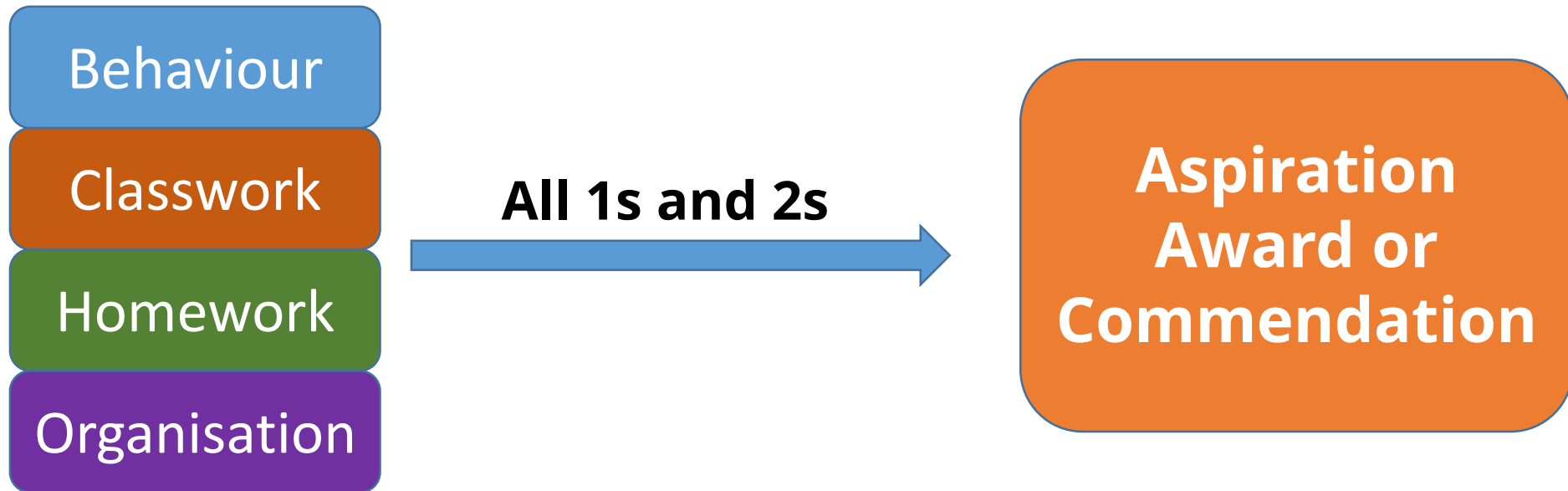

Attitudes to Learning

The Baccalaureate starts with putting your best into your learning. Each term, teachers give you a grade for each of our four Attitudes to Learning from Grade 1 (excellent) to 4 (serious concerns). Students who receive at least all 2s (all good) will receive an Aspiration Commendation and have their name read out in our termly Celebration Assembly. Students who receive approximately 10 1s as well will receive an Aspiration Award and collect a certificate at the assembly.



The Year Awards

Students receive the Year Award if:

- You receive TWO Aspiration Awards or Nominations in a year
- Your Attendance is over 95% (special circumstances are considered)
- You get over 50 House Points
- You participate in a school or outside school club for at least 10 hours
- You complete the Wellbeing coaching course or participate in at least 10 hours of Wellbeing activity
- You contribute at least 5 hours of Community service (Nurture) – 5 hours

Subject Awards and Colours

We promote students enjoying their learning by going beyond the curriculum. Every subject has a subject award which requires sustained commitment to their subjects. These are posted on Insight and on our website. Students can complete these at any time.

The Performing Arts and Sport are special parts of Wood Green. Students who show commitment to Music, Drama and Sport in KS3 and complete the subject awards in these areas will be awarded Half-Colours.

The Wood Green KS3 Bacculaureate

Students who receive two year awards and complete 7 subject awards by the end of year 9 will be awarded the KS3 Bacculaureate.
