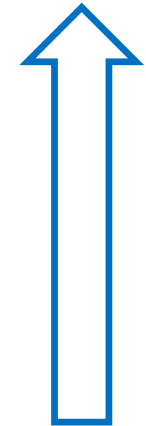


Specialist provision

Alternative Provision:- Individualised timetable, Hospital school, Meadowbrook, TRAX, Abingdon Witney College, Synolos, Common Leys, work experience

Outside professionals:- Educational psychologist, Early Intervention Hub, Team Around the Family, Primary/Child Adolescent Mental Health, Therapists, Attendance Team, Local Authority specialists.



Provision that is additional and different

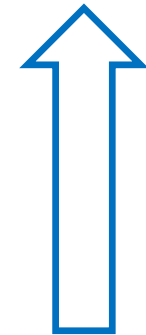
In the classroom:- laptop, reading pen, TA support

Exam concessions:- fully assessed access arrangements, including extra time, laptop, reader, scribe, small room.

Small group Learning and one to one work:- literacy, numeracy, language and communication, autism support, social skills, anxiety and attendance.

Social and emotional support:- school nurse, school counsellor. Pastoral Support Workers, ELSA, Curriculum Support.

Outside the classroom:- support at break and lunch, library, homework support



Provision for ALL students

Teaching and Learning through appropriate differentiation of curriculum, to provide both support and challenge as appropriate. Staff training on specific needs of SEND learners including autism, language and communication.

Pastoral support, PSHE, Wood Green Baccalaureate, extra- curricular activities
