



The polo shirt must always be worn. If a student wishes to wear a jumper, it must only be a Wood Green jumper. Students must wear a polo shirt underneath their jumper. No other jumper must be worn over the polo shirt or jumper with the exception of the Wood Green cardigan and fleece.



Jumpers



Jackets



Jackets should be in a neutral colour and provide protection from the British weather. Hooded tops are not permitted as they do not provide adequate protection from the elements. Denim jackets are also not permitted.



They should be plain black without any brand name anywhere on them. They should be clearly identifiable as shoes and not trainers, plimsolls or dolly shoes. This is because they do not provide adequate protection in the rain. High heels of any kind are not allowed. There should be no branded sportswear name on any shoes. This means no Converse, Vans, Lonsdale, Adidas, Nike or any other branded sports/leisure wear brand. Velcro fastening shoes must have no sportswear logo.

This list is not exhaustive but is to give guidance.. We also appreciate that some parents are placed under pressure by children who say other children are wearing a particular type of shoe. The aim of this guidance is to make expectations very clear for parents and students and reduce the cost for parents. If in doubt about what is acceptable, please ask us.

Shoes



Skirts



These must be plain black formal skirts and must be no more than 5cm above knee height. These must not be tight fitting or short. Examples of acceptable skirt styles are A-line, pleated or skater. Girls must wear plain grey, white or black socks or black or natural tights with their skirt.

Trousers



Trousers should be a tailored plain black design. This means no jeans or trousers with jeans features. This means they should not have rivet details or jean like stitching.

Leggings, cargo pants, chinos or tracksuit bottoms are also not allowed.

Skinny style, smart, tailored trousers are acceptable. They should not have any rivets in the style of jeans.

Skin tight trousers are not acceptable.

We do not believe it is appropriate for girls to wear trousers with the label 'Miss Sexy' on them, so please do not buy them.



PE kit

This remains the same as before and can be bought directly from the supplier.

Jewellery

The only jewellery that is allowed is one set of stud earrings and a watch. There must be no rings, bracelets of any kind or facial piercings, including nose studs, lip piercings and eyebrow piercings.

Hair and make up

This must be one natural colour and not extreme. Boys must be clean shaven. The Headteacher reserves the right to make the final decision on what is an acceptable haircut. If you are in any doubt about whether a particular hairstyle may be considered extreme, please contact your child's HoLC. Make up must be light. in neutral colours and not extreme. Again, the Headteacher reserves the right to make the final decision on what is acceptable with regards to make up. Tattoos are not allowed.
