Safeguarding

The schools in Witney have received reports recently of worrying behaviour on some of the roads, including near to Wood Green. In one incident, a child was approached by a man in a stationary car on Narrow Hill, and in another, the occupants of a car on Hailey Road tried to engage two children in conversation. In addition, we know some of our students witnessed an incident on their way home. Thankfully, no child in any school has been hurt, and children showed initiative by cycling or walking swiftly and safely away and reporting the incident.

We have contacted our police liaison officer for advice to give to our students to help them. We are sure you will want to talk with them about safe behaviour to and from school, particularly as the nights and mornings get darker. All schools in Witney will take similar action.

If your child is involved in anything of this nature, you should always contact the police to report it to them and please let us know at school.
