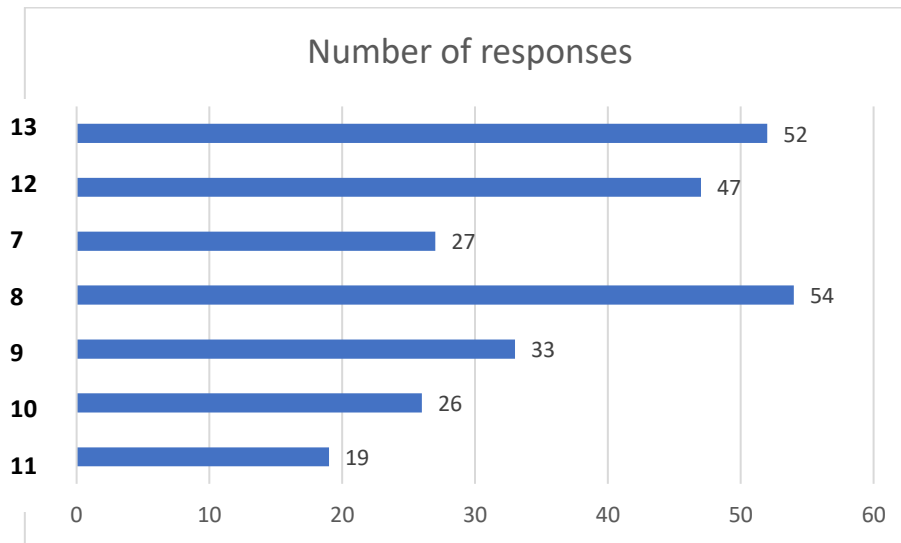


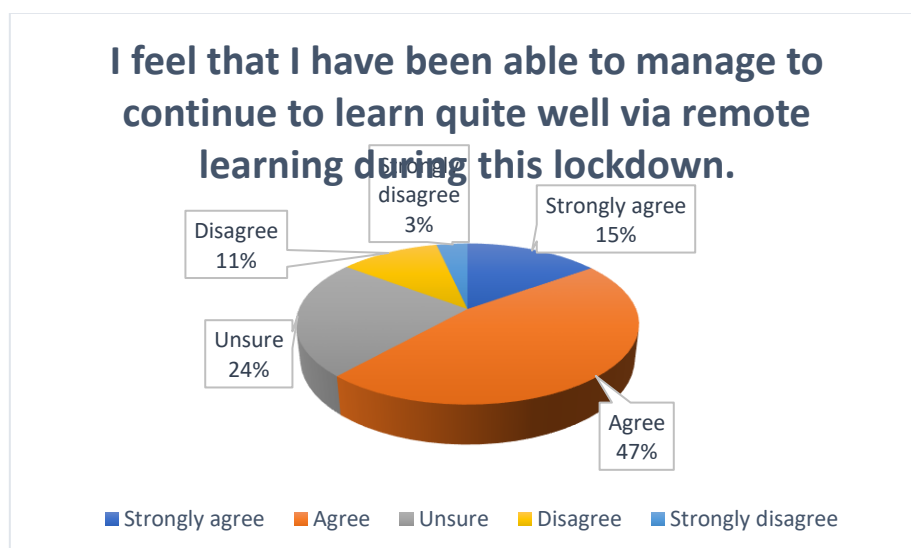
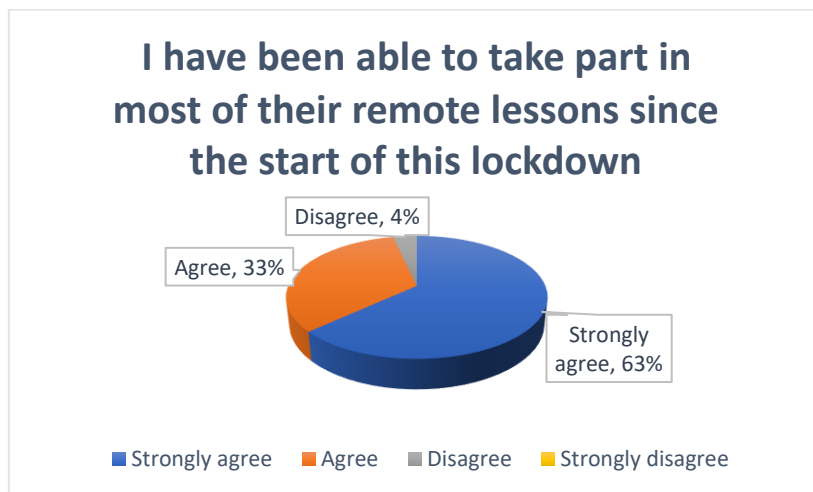
Parent and student remote learning survey January 2021

Student survey results

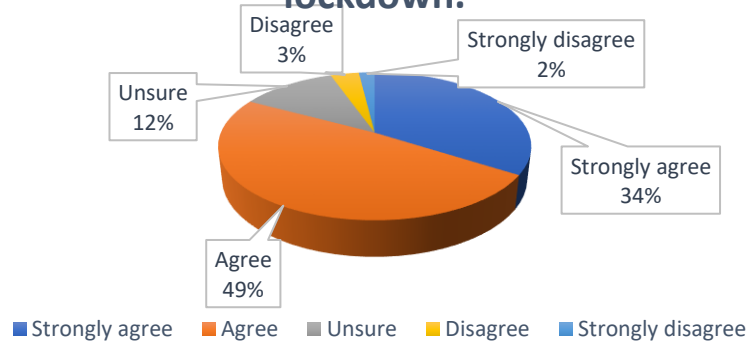
There were 258 responses to the student survey. The breakdown by year group was as follows.



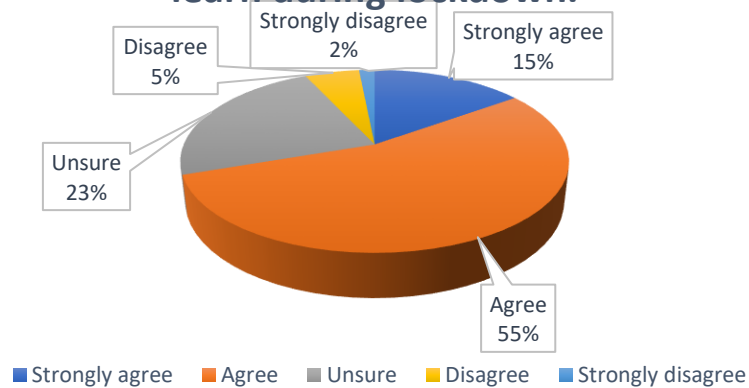
The responses to the individual questions were as follows. There was little difference in the responses between year groups.



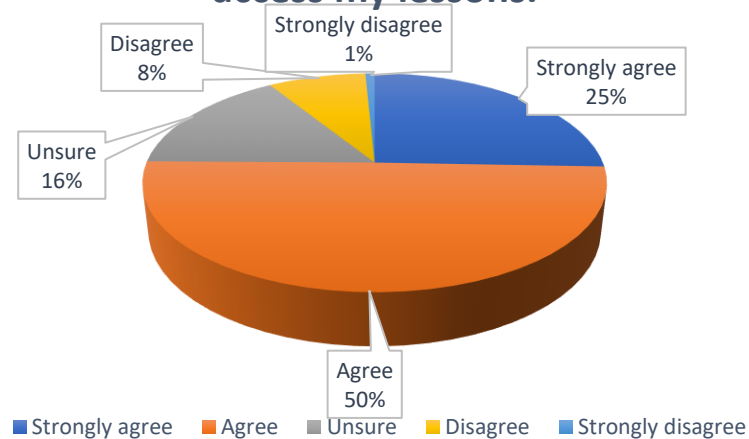
I feel that following my normal timetable has been helpful in allowing me to continue to learn throughout this lockdown.



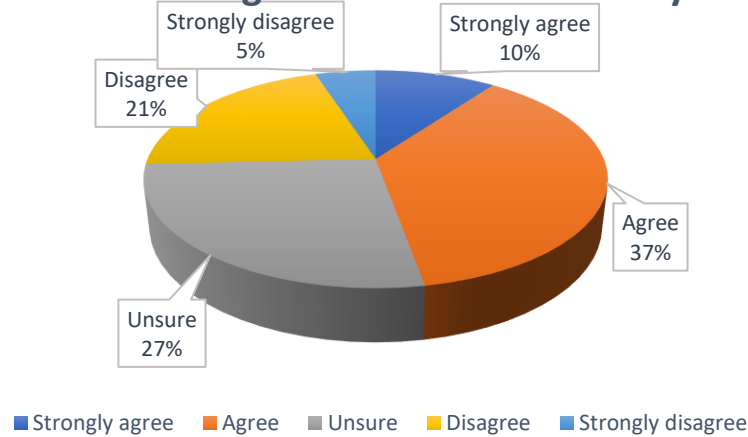
The way that most of my teachers have been teaching remotely has helped me to learn during lockdown.



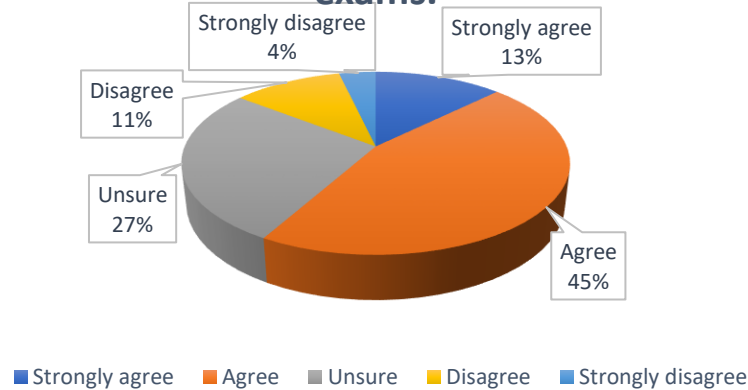
I have found it quite easy to use Teams to access my lessons.

Yr 11 and 13 only. My child knows what they need to do for their upcoming mock exams.



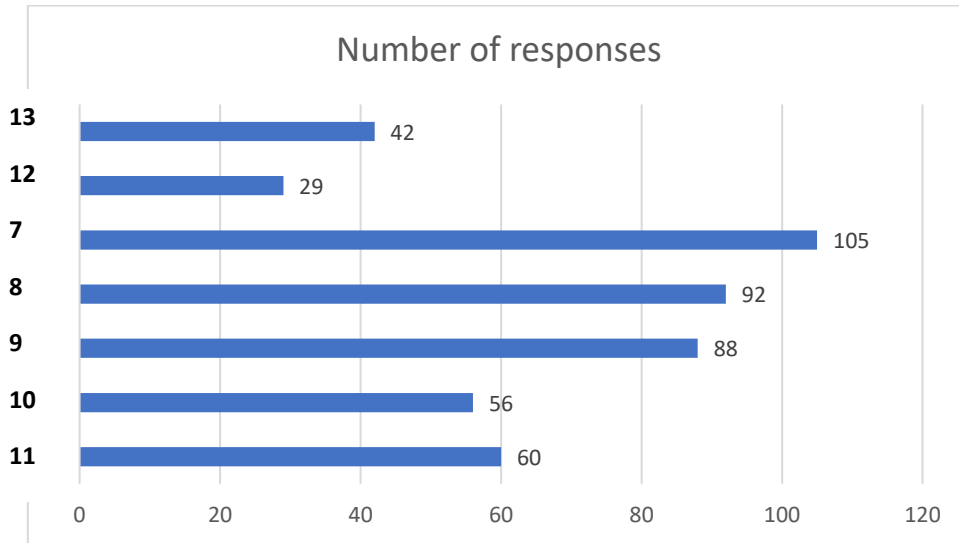
Student comments summary.

Students had found a wide range of strategies that teachers have been using have helped them learn.

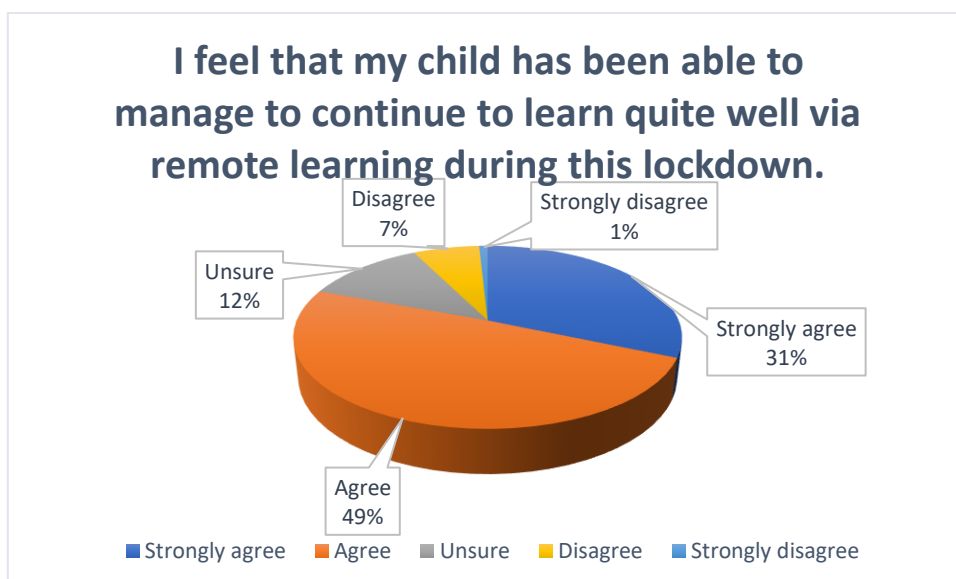
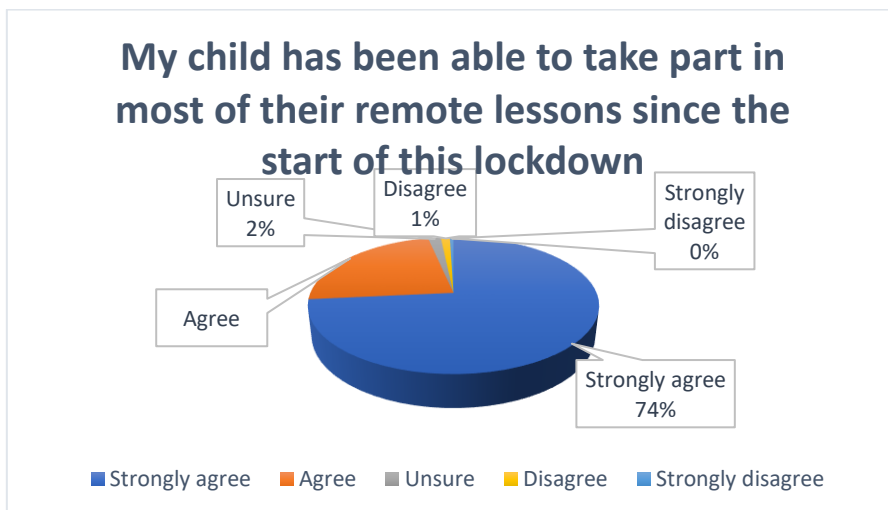
The difficulties students commented on were predominantly technical issues such as audio problems for staff and getting used to new platforms and applications. Some mentioned not having enough time to complete work and there were several comments who said there wasn't enough time between lessons for a break. Some find it harder learning remotely than being in school. Not many mentioned it being a problem having 4-5 lessons a day, although there were some comments saying they were concerned about large amounts of screen time during the day.

Parent survey results

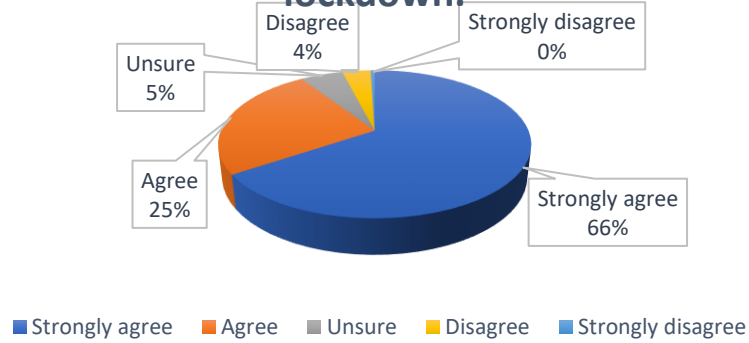
There were 472 responses to this survey. The breakdown by year group was as follows.



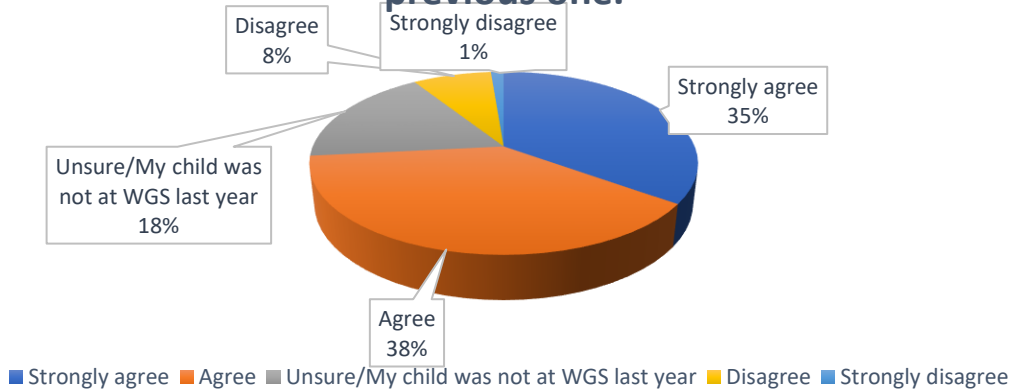
The responses to the individual questions were as follows. There was little difference in responses between year groups.



It has been really helpful for my child to be following their normal timetable during the school day throughout this lockdown.

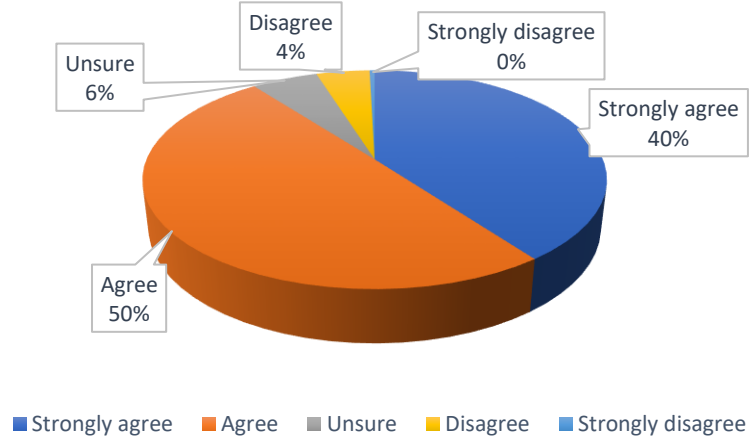


My child has been more engaged with their learning during this lockdown compared to the previous one.

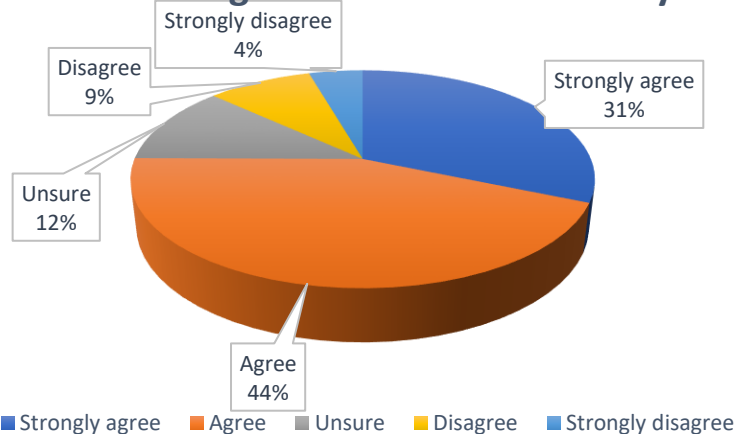

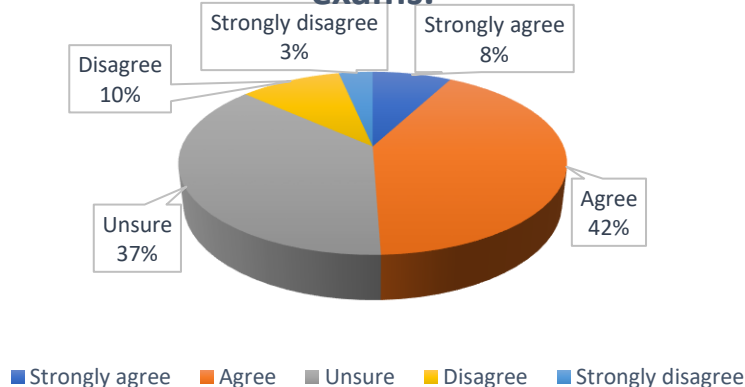
My child has found it easy to use Teams to access their lessons.

Parents comments survey.

There were 290 individual comments by parents. The overwhelming majority were positive about the structure that following the timetable had given their children and the effort from all of the teachers. There were number of comments that said that although remote learning was not ideal, they appreciated that what was being provided was the next best thing. A small number of parents made comments about technical issues and a small number raised concerns about the amount of screen time.
