Dear Parents/Carers

I am delighted to be able to announce that in response to student requests we are launching our Sixth Form Work Experience Scheme for Year 12 going into Year 13.

The purpose of the scheme is to enable every student to gain hands-on experience in potential career areas, or fields of interest which are relevant to them. In our experience, employers and universities rate this very highly.

The scheme will operate as follows:

- Every student will have responsibility for identifying and arranging a suitable placement
- He/she will contact the employer and set this up
- Students will be expected to arrange their placement from 5<sup>th</sup> to the 9<sup>th</sup> of September 2016. Their first day back at school, as Year 13, will be Monday 12<sup>th</sup> September
- If the placement is considered by us to be 'high risk', Oxfordshire County Council will make an assessment and a student will not be able to proceed without their agreement and the student will be asked to pay the cost of this.
- Work Experience forms have been given to students today, a copy may be found on our website
- Students must complete and return the forms by Friday 4<sup>th</sup> March to our Sixth Form Administrator. Unless these have been received and the placement confirmed by us with the employer, it cannot take place
