Y11 Careers Day - Thursday 2nd December

Normally, our Year 11 students would undertake Work Experience in November. Due to COVID restrictions we've been unable to arrange/support Year 11 Work Experience this year. However, we are still providing our Year 11 students with some experience of employers with a focus on emphasising the links between careers and curriculum. This is thought to aid students better understand the relevance of their subjects in their future careers.

As such, we will be holding a **Year 11 Careers Day on Thursday 2nd December.**

On that day, during **Periods 1 and 5**, students will receive presentations about:

- Apprenticeships;
- Abingdon & Witney College - what's on offer, and explanations of and information about T-Levels;
- Soft Skills in the workplace, and
- Online career planning resources, such as;

During **Periods 2, 3 and 4** – students will follow their usual timetable. PE and Science lessons that day will have a real focus on, and link to, skills for careers whilst covering curriculum subjects.

Ignite Sports will be coming in to work with our PE department to inspire potential careers in sports and work with some PE groups.

Healthtec will run a live Teams session for all students undertaking Science during Period 4.
