Dear Parents and Carers,

We would like to inform you that the Science Department at Wood Green has been invited to take part in a standardisation study for progress tests in Science, devised by an institution called GL Assessment who also run CAT testing for the school. As part of this study students in Year 7 will need to complete a 1 hour test paper, answering questions on Science content that will have been covered in primary school.

This is a pilot study and it is planned that these transition tests will be used at the start of secondary education to identify individual strengths and weaknesses and to set a baseline for monitoring progress, during their time in school.

The tests will take place on Tuesday and Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> September in the formal setting of the main school hall. Students are not expected to prepare in any way for this test.
